Dear State Center Credit Union Member:

As you are probably aware The State of California is faced with a budget crisis. If you are employed by the State of California and your income is affected by the current budget crisis, State Center Credit Union can help. The following programs are available to help you:

1. You may qualify for an interest free loan through State Center Credit Union; this loan is to help cover the shortfall in your income caused by the budget crisis. The loan amount is for the net amount of your monthly State check for up to 60 days. Members must apply and sign loan documents and loans may be subject to credit approval.
2. Additionally, State Center Credit Union is offering a loan deferment program to members with loans at State Center Credit Union up to 60 days.

Speak to a State Center Credit Union Loan Representative for complete program details. These programs are designed to financially assist our members that are California State employees affected by the California State budget crisis. If a state employee is not a member of State Center Credit Union he/she can join the credit union and take advantage of these programs. You must contact a State Center Credit Union Loan Representative to apply and receive all program details.
